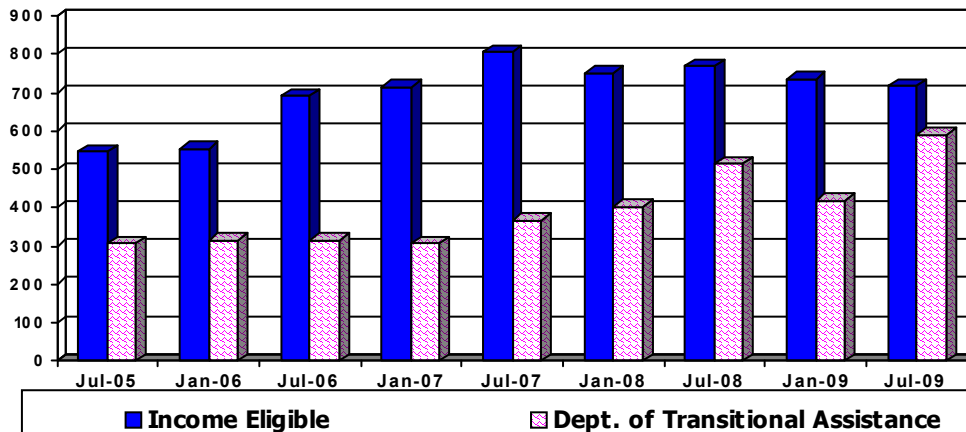

FY'05-FY'09 Trend

- The number of Cape and Islands children receiving Income Eligible vouchers through CCN increased by 32%
- The number of Cape and Islands children receiving DTA vouchers through CCN increased by 92%

Child Care Subsidy Management

With a monthly average of \$562,599.57, CCN efficiently managed and distributed \$6,751,194.75 to 114 Cape & Islands child care voucher providers in fiscal year 2009.

Professional Development

Child Care Network provided 2,139 hours of Professional Development Training to a total of 431 individuals in FY'09.

As one means for increasing the availability of child care, CCN provided the opportunity for 119 people to attend training sessions to start and/or expand existing licensed programs.
